Semillon / Chardonnay 2009 TG 1
Richmond Ridge - Warburns - South East, Australia
Fresh, fruity aromas with tropical and citrus notes carry through onto the palate which is soft and rounded finishing with soft, balanced acidity. 12.5% abv
Bottle - £16.25

Chenin Blanc 2010 TG 2
Rocheburg - Western Cape, S.Africa
Packed with upfront tropical fruit, the nose charms with an abundance of guava and gooseberries. The palate follows through with fruit flavours, balanced by a crisp acid to ensure a fresh and fruity style of wine. 13% abv
Bottle - £16.50

Chardonnay 2010 TG 1
Avanti - Bodegas Borbore - San Juan, Argentina
A slightly richer style, thanks to the use of concentrated, ripe Chardonnay grapes. Floral notes mingle with fresh citrus flavours. A ripe, unoaked style. 13.5% abv

Sauvignon Blanc 2010 TG 1
Fairfield - Marlborough, N Zealand
This is a classic New Zealand Sauvignon blanc, which means plenty of crisp fruit with hints of grapefruit and fresh-cut herbs in a clean, fresh-tasting package with lots of zip. Perfectly balanced and not too tart. 13% abv

Muscadet Sur Lie 2009 TG 1
Les Grands Presbytères - Loire, France
Sourced from St Fiacre - one of the best sites for Muscadet, this wine has delicate pear and apple fruit on the palate with crisp acidity. 12% abv

Pinot Gris 2009/10 TG 3
Villa Wolf - JL Wolf - Pfalz, Germany
Pinot Gris has a very long tradition in the Pfalz region. In fact, it was here that the variety was first identified. This is made in a full-bodied, dry style with refreshing, unoaked fruit and a crackling texture. 13% abv
Bottle - £22.50

Chablis 2009 TG 1
Levert Frères - Burgundy, France
A fuller style of Chablis with a flinty dry and powerful body. Soft, voluptuous fruit is matched by fascinating mineral properties. A long lasting palate that is delicious and memorable. 12.5% abv

Rosado NV TG 3
Casal Mendes - Caves Aliança - Vinho de Mesa, Portugal
Strawberry & pepper, with a good hint of spritz. A cleansing finish with a final zip of strawberry fruit. 10.5% abv

Pinot Grigio Rosé 2010 TG 1
San Antonio - Casa Botter - Veneto, Italy
Slightly fruity & incredibly easy to drink (be careful!). Supremely elegant, it's a delicious experience. 12.5% abv

Shiraz / Cabernet 2009 TG C
Richmond Ridge - Warburns - South East, Australia
Aromas of pepper, spice & plum fruit with undertones of cedary oak. Dark berry flavours plus spice & pepper are generous on the palate. The tannins are soft and firm and balanced with subtle sweet oak. 13% abv
Bottle - £16.25

Vista TR 2007 TG C
Caves Aliança - Beiras, Portugal
Rich, ripe, generous, dark chewy fruit, good structure with no hard edges and good length. It could be argued that it's about ¾ Portuguese and ¼ New world with the right blend of the best bits of both. 13% abv
Bottle - £16.95

Pinotage 2008 TG C
Rocheburg - Western Cape, S.Africa
The colour is an attractive bright ruby red with a purple rim, typical of a young Pinotage. Complex and exciting with ripe plum and fruitcake all beautifully integrated and then finished with subtle oak. 14% abv

Malbec 2010 TG D
Avanti - Bodegas Borbore - San Juan, Argentina
Made from 100% Malbec grapes from the Tulum valley. Intense dark purple fruits on the nose. A well balanced palate with soft tannins and perfect with steaks. 13.5% abv
Bottle - £17.95

Côtes du Rhône 2008 TG B
Reserve des Benedictines - Pierre Dupond - Rhône, France
Milk chocolate and white pepper meet berry fruit, with this surprisingly fresh example of CDR. Not quite rustic - but a real bistro wine. 13.5% abv
Bottle - £18.50

Barbera d'Asti 2007 TG D
Ceppi Storici - Araldica - Piemonte, Italy
The classic, vibrant damson, curranty character of Barbera is given another layer here via the subtle use of a blend of old and new oak. Fresh and juicy with a subtle smoky flavour. 14% abv

Rioja Tinto 2008/9 TG C
Montesc - Bodegas Classica - Rioja, Spain
75% Crianza Rioja (min 12 months in barrels) and 25% young Rioja (aged for 4 months). This results in a wine with all the silky softness you would expect from a Crianza, but much juicier and with more red fruit flavour. 13.5% abv
Bottle - £20.95

Pinot Noir 2009 TG B
Reserva - Viña Ventisquero - Central Valley, Chile
Elegant, with a fresh and juicy attack, harmonic and velvety structure, due to soft and round tannins and an after taste of tobacco and toasty notes. 13.5% abv
